Vineyards / Winemaking:

Our vineyard thrives in Goldridge soil formations on the northern slopes above the Russian River just west of the Wohler Bridge. Cool summer nights and morning fog render natural acidity and balance to the lovely fruit grown on this site. Sustainably farmed by Rick Moshin and owners Richard & Terri Milkovich, this 4.5 acre vineyard is planted to old clones Wädenswil 2A, Pommard 5, and Calera. We harvest fruit earlier when flavors mature and acidity is bright. Natural winemaking using native yeast, temperature-controlled fermentation, and minimal intervention allow place, varietal, and vintage to shine.

Tasting Notes:

A sunny, bright Pinot Noir exhibiting an elegant and nuanced old-world style. Aromas of mushroom and rich soil lead to baking spices, rose petal and violet. Aromas and flavors of cherry, cranberry with briary wild tones and rich stone fruit of black and red plum. Hints of cinnamon, all-spice, iron meaty notes and toasted oak add further complexity. Cool and silky on the palate yet providing a supple richness and lingering, mouthwatering finish. Evolving nicely with aeration, this well-structured wine will benefit from further cellaring. Drink now through 2025.
