Vineyards / Winemaking:

Our vineyard thrives on the northern slopes above the Russian River just west of the Wohler Bridge in a Goldridge soil formation with 18-22% clay content and some iron deposits. The Rosalina Vineyard, rising 180' feet above Westside Road, is now in prime stride as the 2019 vintage brings it to its 13th leaf. Cool summer nights and morning fog render natural acidity and balance to the lovely fruit grown on this site. Sustainably farmed by Rick Moshin and owners Richard & Terri Milkovich, this 1 2 acre plot at the top of the slope is planted to old clone Alsace-07. We harvest fruit earlier when flavors mature, pH is low, and acidity is bright. Natural winemaking utilizing native yeast, temperature-controlled fermentation, and minimal intervention allow place, varietal, and vintage to shine.
