2016 Rosalina Vineyard Pinot Noir featured at the July 2019 event in McMinnville, OR

Rosalina Vineyard – Planted on the western edge of the *Middle Reach* of the Russian River Valley in 2007 to Wädenswil 2A, Pommard 5, and Calera clones in iron rich Goldridge soils containing 18-22% clay content. Climbing 180' above Westside Road, this five-acre vineyard sits on a south facing, 15-20° slope above the river just north of *Green Valley*.
